Tournament Rules

1. The tournament will be held at North Versailles lanes , 412-824-6700 on Saturday March 21st and Sunday March 22th, 2020 at 1 PM on Saturday and at 1PM and 3PM on Sunday.
2. This is a singles tournament with highest three game total with handicap being the winner. After closing date, walk-ins will be accepted one (1) hour before squad time and depending on lane availability.
3. No refund of tournament fees after closing date of the tournament.
4. This tournament is USBC certified. All prize fees will be returned 100%with at least one prize for every five (5) entries.
5. HANDICAP. 90% based on a 220 average.
6. Highest final 2018-2019 USBC certified league average for 21 games or more. If no 2018-2019 average, then current season average, 21 games or more, as of entry closing date. Current average must be verified in writing by league secretary. If no average meets these requirements, you must bowl scratch. FAILURE TO USE CORRECT AVERAGE SHALL DISQUALIFY SCORE IF SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN CORRECT AVERAGE, THEREBY RESULTING IN MORE HANDICAP. Prize money will be issued on the submitted average if it is higher than correct average. However, corrections in average may be made up to the completion of the first game of the series. USBC rules 319A-2,319C, 319D and 319E will not apply.
7. The entrant whose name appears, or their authorized replacement, hereby agrees that Pittsburgh Women's 600 Bowling Club, its officers and agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when those entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary scheduled changes, or premature termination of the tournament that may be brought about by war, national emergency or by causes relating thereto, or resulting there from fires, strikes , etc. beyond the control of the Pittsburgh Women's 600 Bowling Club.
8. NO OPEN BOWLING BY ANY PARTICIPANT ON THE TOURNAMENT LANES ON THE DAY OF TOURNAMENT WILL BE PERMITTED.
9. In case of a tie, co-champions will be declared.
10. All entrants must be a member of USBC and the Pittsburgh Women's 600 Bowling Club.
11. A bowler arriving late may bowl but score will begin in the frame being bowled. Zero will be given for all missed frames.
12. A \$35.00 service fee will apply to any returned check.
